

DIRECTIONS TO WINSTON SALEM, Bankruptcy Court

The trip from Concord to the Bankruptcy Court takes approximately one and a half hours.

1. Go north on I-85 toward Salisbury. Go past Salisbury approximately 60 miles, altogether. At that point, the road signs will say "Lexington." Travel past the bridge over the Yadkin River, notable because the highway descends rather sharply to the bridge. Go past the US Flea Market, notable because it has several very large American flags out front.
2. Old I-85, "Business 85," splits off a mile or two after the flea market, The exist is to the **right**, so get in the right hand lane and watch for signs. The signs say north to Winston Salem. Do not go toward Greensboro.
3. Old I-85 blends into Highway 52. Stay on 52. Pass over I-40.
4. When you start getting close to Winston-Salem, you will be able to see the buildings downtown. Start to look for **Stadium Drive**, and take exit (exit 108C). Turn right onto Stadium Drive. Signs will direct you to "Old Salem." Follow those signs.
5. Stadium Drive dead ends at a stop light into **Salem Avenue**. Turn right.
6. Just before you get to the overpass, turn **LEFT** onto **CEMETARY STREET** (there is a cemetery also on the left).
7. Go down two city blocks (the first block you will cross over is Main Street). The second block (which has a light) is Liberty Street. As you sit at this light, you will see a parking lot across from you.
8. Cross Liberty Street and go into the parking lot. There are old warehouses here.
9. Follow the parking lot between the two old warehouses and you will see the US Bankruptcy Court.
